First Aid Training

On Monday of this week on Professional Development Day, the seven class teachers plus Mrs. Loades, Miss English, Mr. Bland, Susan, Pamela and Mr. Lidster our caretaker all had training in Emergency First Aid to achieve their certificates. Over the course of the day, they had experience in dealing with a range of issues including bandaging, grazes, burns, strains, broken bones, concussions, CPR and the recovery position.

The next round of training will involve Reception staff in refreshing their Paediatric First Aid training in March and finally the lunchtime supervisors will revisit their training before Easter. The kitchen staff who supervise Breakfast Club and lunch have their certificates renewed via Taylor Shaw.



An important consequence to the training is that the school shortly intends to buy a defibrillator which, in serving the local community, also has the potential to save lives.
